To allow time for the competition on this occasion our AGM will commence at 7pm.

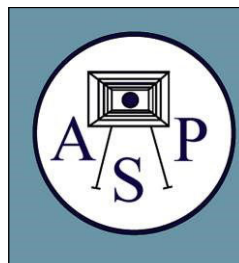
