LandscapePro

LandscapePro is a photo editor with a difference. Unlike general purpose programs equipped with the usual set of filters, brushes and colour correction tools, it's designed specifically for enhancing landscape shots, and the results can be as subtle or dramatic as you like. LandscapePro is a standalone or Photoshop plug-in which allows you to change virtually every aspect of a landscape. Replace skies. Turn day to night. Add snow or thunderclouds.
