The Gurkha Welfare Trust has recently decided to name a new school building in memory of former Rugeley resident and Rugeley & Armitage Camera Club member, Margaret Cross. Margaret worked tirelessly for more than 20 years with husband Rob to support former Gurkha soldiers and their families, raising nearly £110,000. Rob, a member of Lichfield St. Chad's Rotary Club, is a keen photographer and former chairman of Lichfield Camera Club. Both he and Margaret have given talks about Nepal and the Gurkhas to community groups, illustrating their presentations with some stunning photographs of their lives in and travels to Nepal and other far-flung places. Their efforts were acknowledged with the award of an MBE to Rob in the 2021 New Year's Honours List. Sadly, Margaret passed away last August and it is entirely fitting that she will be given a permanent memorial in a community she did so much to support.
